Session: Applying the new SPSP Essentials of Safe Care within SPSP Mental Health

Aims of Session:

- Consider the impact of effective clinical governance on quality and safety of care
- Explore the new SPSP Essentials of Safe Care drivers and change ideas and how these can be applied in the context of mental health care settings
- Share examples of SPSP Essentials of Safe Care improvement work from health boards

The newly launched SPSP Mental Health Programme will focus on quality of care and safety at the point of transfer from acute mental health services to community mental health care.

Improving the quality and safety of care is dependent on an effective clinical governance framework across parts of the healthcare system. Delegates will hear from NHS Grampian on their approach to developing clinical governance structures that support cross-organisational working. This will be followed by an exploration of the refreshed SPSP Essentials of Safe Care drivers and how these might be applied in the context of mental health settings as part of SPSP Mental Health.

Session: Perinatal and Paediatric Approach to The SPSP Essentials of Safe Care

Aims of Session:

- Understand family-integrated approaches to reducing term admissions
- Explore family inclusion in the care of deteriorating children and young people
- Provide the opportunity for group discussion and networking with colleagues across Scotland (in person attendees only)

In this breakout session, guest presenters will share their safety-focussed improvement work through the lens of the SPSP Essentials of Safe Care.

Attendees will have the opportunity to reflect on how involving families in care, supports effective communication and safe clinical and health processes.

Session: Continuous Improvement to Embed the SPSP Essentials of Safe Care within SPSP Adults in Hospital

- Opportunity for group discussion and networking with colleagues across Scotland (in person attendees only)
