- This checklist can be utilised as an aid for quality assurance, before during and after a scheduled tool run.
- It is recommended that any tool run preparation should be carried out 6 to 8 weeks prior to the tool run commencing.
- During the preparation stage, named contacts should be confirmed to provide quality assurance for the duration of the run.

<p><u>Tools:</u> Confirm which tools are to be run for the roster:</p> <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where available, specialty specific tools should be completed alongside the Professional Judgement (PJ) tool within SSTS. • For areas with no specialty specific tool only the PJ tool should be completed (this can be on SSTS or Excel) • For Community Nursing, CCSN and CNS the Quality Tool should also be completed, this is not mandated, but recommended, to support triangulation. 			

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<p><u>Housekeeping:</u></p> <p>SSTS: confirm the following are correct, where applicable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rosters (Tool Alignment, specialty etc.) • Bed Numbers (actual and occupancy for previous financial year) • Funded Establishment • Tool access for all relevant staff also requires confirmation <p>BOXI: Confirm access for appropriate reports and rosters</p>			
<p>SafeCare: confirm the following are correct, where applicable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rosters • Census Periods • Bed Numbers • Patient Types and Task Types • Steps for reporting on the staffing level tool run 			
<p>Excel for professional Judgement: When required to utilise the Excel document for Professional judgment confirm the following has been completed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WFL or equivalent lead has attended Professional Judgement Excel training • Training has been cascaded to the relevant staff • There is an audit trail of the training in-house • The appropriate excel document is shared with the specific area/department 			

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<p>Communicate to all relevant staff:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The planned dates for the tool run • Training dates 			
<p>Staff Training:</p> <p>Including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tool training on relevant platform – SSTS and/or SafeCare • Expectations • Provision of guidance documents, learning resources and data collection templates e.g. via HSP toolkit • Common Staffing Method (CSM) 			
<p>Confirm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who will provide quality assurance throughout the run and feedback to staff when required? • Who will quality assure the data on a shift-by-shift basis? • Who will validate the data (senior staff member)? • Who will enter the data on SSTS; SafeCare; Excel? • Who will complete the issues log - this is locally owned and managed within board. 			

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During Run (The first 24 hours)

Ensure the data collection starts on time			
Complete the Professional Judgement tool for each shift (refer to training resources for Professional Judgement on SSTS and Excel)			
Ensure workload is being captured and correct levels of care identified			
Communicate and feedback resolution of issues/ clarifications/ glitches			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collate completed paper templates and store in line with local governance policies, ready for quality assurance and upload to SSTS and/or SafeCare <p>SafeCare data is uploaded on a daily basis at the appropriate census periods- a minimum of two census periods should be recorded during your staffing level tool run. Emergency care Provision Staffing Level Tool data is entered retrospectively</p>			
During Run (Week 1)			
Ensure workload and professional judgement data is being collected correctly for all relevant shifts and data capture templates are being collated and stored as above.			

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<p>If data entry into SSTS and/or SafeCare has begun – Consider the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If data is being entered from data collection templates, has all information been collected? • Have senior staff had sight of information prior to tool input for quality assurance, if necessary? • 3Cs - have all planned staff began entering their data? • Are staff entering data at the correct census period within SafeCare and using the PJ tool within SSTS? 			
<p>Are issues being recorded in the issues log, and escalated where required?</p>			

During Run (At the end of week 1)

<p>Does the tool reflect the workload activity over the past week? If not has all activity been correctly captured?</p>			
<p>Are any variations and exceptions in workload activity recorded within the tool or professional judgement, where appropriate?</p>			
<p>Is the first week of professional judgement data reflective of the workload activity?</p>			
<p>Have concerns been flagged with the team leader and or senior charge nurse/midwife where appropriate?</p>			

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<p>Communicate with the team as to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How the first week has gone • Actions for week two • feedback resolution of issues/ clarifications/ glitches • the plan for discussing tool run outputs and application of the Common Staffing Method 			
<p>3Cs Tools:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have all planned staff completed the tool? • Have data quality issues (including missed days or significant differences between actual hours worked and workload total) been identified and fed back to the appropriate staff members? 			
<p>Quality Tool (3Cs Specific):</p> <p>Completion of the Quality Tool is not mandated but recommended to be used to support the triangulation process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has this been completed with input from the team? • Is this reflective of the service provision?

During Run (At the end of week 2 continued)

<p>Have any identified issues been feedback to the appropriate staff member?</p>			

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<p>Have any ongoing issues been escalated or unexpected scores flagged to senior staff?</p>			
<p>Communicate with the team as to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How the second week has gone • Feedback resolution of issues/ clarifications/ glitches • The plan for discussing tool run outputs and application of CSM 			
<p>3Cs Tools:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have all planned staff completed the tool? • Have data quality issues (including missed days or significant differences between actual hours worked and workload total) been identified and fed back to the appropriate staff members? 			
<p>Quality Tool (3Cs Specific):</p> <p>Completion of the Quality Tool is not mandated but recommended to be used to support the triangulation process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has this been completed with input from the team? • Is this reflective of the service provision?

Has all relevant data been entered onto SSTS (if applicable)			
Has all relevant data been entered onto Safecare (if applicable)			
Have all of the points previously highlighted been resolved/ discussed as required? Review Issues Log, which may inform learning and improvements for next tool run			
Have any relevant concerns been escalated to senior staff?			
Have senior staff accessed and validated the tool outputs (both on SSTS and/or SafeCare)?			
Does the tool recommended whole time equivalent (rWTE) reflect workload and existing actual WTE where applicable?			
Has the appropriate tool BOXI report been run and checked for data quality issues? Is the report reflective of workload? – If applicable			
Has the appropriate data been submitted to HSP to enable data outputs from Safecare – if applicable			

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<p>Quality Tool (3Cs specific):</p> <p>Completion of the Quality Tool is not mandated but recommended to be used to support the triangulation process.</p> <p>Has the tool been completed for both weeks? (can be checked via BOXI report)</p> <p>If scores are below 70%, has this been escalated to senior staff?</p>			
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After the Tool Run (continued)
